Subject: Notice of Intent to Adopt Castac Lake Valley Groundwater Basin Groundwater Sustainability Plan

Dear Ms. Oviatt and Mr. Christensen,

In accordance with California Water Code (CWC) §10728.4, the Castac Basin Groundwater Sustainability Agency (Castac Basin GSA), which was formed in 2018 by a Joint Powers Agreement between Tejon-Castac Water District, Lebec County Water District, and the County of Kern pursuant to CWC §10723(a), is hereby providing notice to the cities and counties within the geographic area covered by the Castac Lake Valley Groundwater Basin Groundwater Sustainability Plan (Castac GSP) that it intends to adopt the Castac GSP no earlier than 90 days after your receipt of this notice. The Castac GSP is expected to be adopted by the Castac Basin GSA Board following a public hearing in Summer 2020 and, once adopted, will be implemented within the Castac Basin GSA area in compliance with the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (Part 2.74 of the CWC) and associated regulations.

The Castac Basin GSA will review and consider the comments on the Castac GSP from the recipients of this notice and will consult with a city or county that requests consultation within 30 days of receipt of this notice.
